2015 Contest Rules

DEADLINE: Entries must be postmarked between November 1, 2014 and January 19, 2015 (Edgar Allan Poe's Birthday). Entries must be received by February 1, 2015

Entries will NOT be accepted by e-mail.

All entries must be in English, unpublished, original, and not scheduled for publication before April, 2015. Author retains copyright.

Entries must be typed. Use white 8.5 x 11 inch paper and standard fonts, 12 - 14 point.

Poems that have previously won a monetary award in a PSV contest are ineligible. Submit only one poem per category. Only one category may be entered per poem.

Submit two copies of each poem. Both copies must have the category name and number on top left of page. Only **one** copy must include the poet's name, address, e-mail address if any, and phone number on top right of page, Note membership status in the PSV.

Entry fee for non-members: \$4 per poem. Checks payable to PSV. There are no contest fees for PSV members. Send all entries in one envelope. Include fees. Write a single check to cover all entered contest categories. If you are joining, pay dues with a separate check.

Entries will be recycled. All entries not in compliance will be disqualified.

Winning poems will be read and honored at the 2015 Poetry Virginia Awards Ceremony

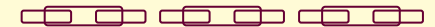

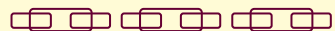

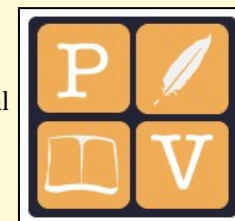
