The Awards Ceremony is our one annual gathering to celebrate the excellence of our own members' writing. This year, in the 25 categories of the adult contest, we received 1,883 poems from 141 poets, some of whom reside outside the state. Each category was judged by a different poet—all very well-published, and hailing from across the nation. If you've won a prize or an honorable mention, please come to bask in your praise. If you did not win, or even if you did not enter, please come to celebrate the achievement of those who did, and to gather together with PSV members from all across our state.

The Raffle:

The Awards Ceremony exists to celebrate achievement in the writing of poetry. And also, we hope, to foster the appreciation as well as the writing of good poetry! What better way to do this than to give away autographed poetry collections, by some of Virginia's leading poets, for our members to read and be inspired by? So this year we're raffling off—free—about five such books. To enter, all you have to do is pre-register for the event and to attend it.
